<p>UNIFORM LABELLING LOST PROPERTY</p>	<p>All pupil property at school must be clearly labelled. This particularly applies to clothing items.</p> <p>Whilst every effort is made to trace lost property and to encourage children to look after their belongings, parents are asked to note that the school cannot accept responsibility for the loss of, or damage to, personal property. There is a lost property box in school.</p>
<p>JEWELLERY</p>	<p>We do not allow any jewellery to be worn during sporting activities. We would prefer that no jewellery be worn in school at all. The children must take earrings out themselves and unless they are able to do this they should not be worn. The older children may wear watches, but these remain their own responsibility.</p>
<p>HAIRSTYLES</p>	<p><u>Girls:</u> No extreme hairstyles. Hair extensions are not allowed. Hair must be one natural colour. Long hair should be tied back with a dark coloured bobble. No fashion accessories in hair.</p> <p><u>Boys:</u> should not wear their hair excessively long or short. Hair length must not be less than a number 3 cut. Extreme styles are not allowed. Hair must be one natural colour. These rules correspond to those at our High School, St. Edmund Arrowsmith. We rely on our parents who entrust their children's education to us, to support us in this matter.</p>
